

PLACEMENT TEST CHART

Exempt students are eligible to enroll in ENC 1101 College Composition I, MAT 1033 Intermediate Algebra, or MGF 1100 Introduction to Mathematical Thinking. Exempt students may also provide placement test scores to place into a higher-level math course.

Non-exempt students must provide appropriate test scores to place into ENC 1101 College Composition I, MAT 1033 Intermediate Algebra, MGF 1100 Introduction to Mathematical Thinking, MAC 1105 College Algebra, MAC 1105C College Algebra with Integrated Review, MGF 1130 Mathematical Thinking, MGF 1131 Mathematics in Context, or STA 2023 Elementary Statistics I. If a student places into ENC 0022 Foundations of Communications with either their PERT Writing or Reading score, they must successfully pass ENC 0022 Foundations of Communications prior to enrolling in ENC 1101 College Composition I.
