Librarians and related support staff are available at the South Lake and Leesburg campus libraries as well as virtually to assist you with researching and finding information, including assistance with citation formats (APA, MLA), integrating source materials into writing, and understanding technology to complete your class assignments.

The libraries provide a variety of books, e-books, online articles, and streaming videos to support course-related research and other learning needs. You may check out materials at any campus library with a college ID. You may also request materials from other libraries through interlibrary loan. Currently enrolled students may access online resources using their network login information.
